## CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The *Journal of Law & Cyber warfare* (JLCW) is soliciting articles about the legal dimensions of information security and cyber warfare. JLCW is an internationally refereed journal dedicated to examining the advancement of the laws and policies surrounding cyber warfare. Our purpose is to promote and record of state-of-the-art research in this dynamic area. All manuscripts accepted by JLCW will appear online and in a printed hard copy.

We welcome writing on subjects including, but not limited to, Theoretical Jurisprudence, Information Security Law, Law of War, Legal Proceedings, the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA), Cyber security Legislation, Computer Vulnerabilities, Information Payloads, and Interdisciplinary Studies as they relate to cyber warfare. We strongly encourage analysis of the international dimensions of these topics. JLCW is an interdisciplinary journal and welcomes contributions from the fields of law, information technology, computer science, dispute resolution, and other disciplines concerned with the law of information security and cyber warfare.

We accept manuscripts, articles, and comments. We are also interested in short papers (letters), short surveys or position papers that explore specific problems. Authors of such short papers will be invited to write a regular piece for future issues of the JLCW tracking the development of their topic.

We find that most Articles require a modest degree of editing to comply with The Bluebook and the Chicago Manual of Style. However, we also believe our authors make their arguments most effectively when they speak in their own voice — differences of stylistic opinion are rarely worth the loss of collegiality between author and editor. Because of the time and effort devoted to the process of reviewing articles, the Editorial Board requests that authors who submit articles to JLCW do not submit the same article to other journals at the same time.
